can̄t̄ki'ya, v.a. To love one, make him one's heart. Can̄lwakiya. Can̄lmakiya.

can̄tfu', n. The chest. Wakiyela s'e-kin niško nañkin na. - neñs Wahacañka Sapa, i.e. John Big Crow's grandfather, perhaps, invited many people to attend the wailing for his son who had been killed, and he heard the saying: It's e - ecila wičaša ota ciñ yelo; niconalapi eyas bliheis'iya po. Bl.

can̄tfu'ipasise, n. A breast pin, a badge.

can̄tfu' sápeļa, n. A little bird with a black breast, a tail wanblupi s'e-lececa, back black, i.e. Mota, and head like that of the ištanica tañka. Bl.

canto'gin, Same as canteogin.

canto'gnagya, v.a. To cause to place in the heart. Cañtognawaya. -- adv. In a loving manner.

canto'gnaka, v.a. (cante, ognaka). To place in the affections, to love. Cantowagnaka.

canto'gnakapi, n. Love.

canto'juha, n. A tobacco bag.

canto'gnignaka, v. pos. (cañtognaka). To place in one's heart. Cañtowaki-gnake.

canto'kpani, v.a. (cante, okpani). To long for. Cantowakpani.

canto'kpanipi, n. A longing for.

canto'kpaniyañ, v.a. To cause to long for. Cañtokpaniwaya. Wahapi kiñ cañtowakpani yelo. Lehañyan wahi kiñ locanteowakpani yelo. -- adv. Longing for. Bl.

canto'peya, v.a. To cheer up. Same as canlopeya. Cañtopewaya.

cañuñ'keenna, n. Ill scented sumac; skunkbush. Also, cañuñkeenna cañ or hu. Rhus coriaria variety, trilobata. The gray cashew family. The leaves are mingled with tobacco and smoked. Bl. #61.

can̄wacikiyapi, n. A top.

can̄walpa tāñka, n. The bronzed grackle. He says: Mat'i ni, or: Cu-ali. i.e. tuwa koška ehantans. Bl. GA. FR.

can̄wa'kan, n. A flag pole.

can̄wa'ksa, v. To saw wood. Cañwawaksa.

can̄ws'káica, n. A wooden dish or plate.

can̄wak'in, n. A saddle. - hu, The saddle bow. - pasú, A saddle horn.

can̄wa'pe, n. Leaves; small branches.

- gi wi, September, the moon in which the leaves turn brown. - Kasñ wi, October, the moon when the wind shakes off the leaves. - wakañ. - wohesma, Thick leaves or foliage. Cf. cañiyuwi iysececa.

can̄wa'pto wi, n. May, the moon in which the leaves are green.

can̄wa'sleca, v.a. To saw lengthwise.

can̄wa'slecapi, n. Wood sawed lengthwise, a plank, boards; sawing, the making of boards.

can̄wa'slesleca, v.a. To saw boards, to saw lengthwise of the wood often.

can̄wa'ta, n. A log canoe, a skiff.

can̄wi'cajipe, n. A drawing knife.

can̄wi'cipaga, n. A cross.

can̄wi'lute, n. Logwood, containing red dye stuff.

can̄winja, n. A floor.

can̄wi'pasnot, n. A spit or stick to take hold of and roast meat on.

can̄wi'pta, n. A little grove or island of trees. Cf. cañpata.

can̄wi'yowa, n. (cañ, wiyowa). A pencil. Mazawiyowa, A pen.

can̄wi'yufe, n. A wood measure, a cord stick.

can̄wi'yuwi, n. Curled wood, a vine.

can̄wi'yuze, n. A sharp stick to take meat out etc. from a kettle.

can̄wo'gnaka, n. A coffin. Note: cañgnaka. A box.

can̄wo'jupi, n. A park, a tree nursery; an orchard.
