

CA'ŦKIYA

ca'Ŧki'ya, v.a. To love one, make him one's heart. Ca'Ŧwakiya. Ca'Ŧmakiya.

ca'Ŧku', n. The chest. Waki'nyela s'e - ki'Ŧ ni'sko na'ki'Ŧ na. - nai'Ŧs Wahaca'Ŧ-ka Sapa, i.e. John Big Crow's grandfather, perhaps, invited many people to attend the wailing for his son who had been killed, and he heard the saying: I's'e - ecola wloasa ota ci'Ŧ yelo; nioonalapi eyas blihele'iya po. Bl.

ca'Ŧku'ifasise, n. A breast pin, a badge.

ca'Ŧku' sapela, n. A little bird with a black breast, a tail wa'blupi s'e-lececa, back black, i.e. Nota, and head like that of the istanica ta'Ŧka. Bl.

ca'Ŧto'gin, Same as canteogin.

ca'Ŧto'gnagya, v.a. To cause to place in the heart. Ca'Ŧtognawaya. -- adv. In a loving manner.

ca'Ŧto'gnaka, v.a. (cante, ognaka). To place in the affections, to love. Ca'Ŧtowagnaka.

ca'Ŧto'gnakapi, n. Love.

ca'Ŧto'juha, n. A tobacco bag.

ca'Ŧto'kignaka, v. pos. (ca'Ŧtognaka). To place in one's heart. Ca'Ŧtowakignaka.

ca'Ŧto'kpani, v.a. (cante, okpani). To long for. Ca'Ŧtowakpani.

ca'Ŧto'kpanipi, n. A longing for.

ca'Ŧto'kpaniya'Ŧ, v.a. To cause to long for. Ca'Ŧtokpaniwaya. Waha'Ŧpi ki'Ŧ ca'Ŧtowakpani yelo. Leha'Ŧya'Ŧ wahi ki'Ŧ lo-ca'Ŧteowakpani yelo. -- adv. Longing for. Bl.

ca'Ŧto'peya, v.a. To cheer up. Same as ca'Ŧlopeya. Ca'Ŧtopewaya.

ca'Ŧu'Ŧkceanna, n. Ill scented sumac; skunkbush. Also, ca'Ŧu'Ŧkceanna ca'Ŧ or hu. Rhus coriaria variety, trilobata. The gray cashew family. The leaves are mingled with tobacco and smoked. Bl. #61.

ca'Ŧwacikiyapi, n. A top.

CA'ŦWOJUPI

ca'Ŧwai'pa ta'Ŧka, n. The bronzed grackle. He says: Mat'i ni, or: Cu-Ŧli, i.e. tuwa ko'ska eha'Ŧta'Ŧs. Bl. GA. FR.

ca'Ŧwa'ka'Ŧ, n. A flag pole.

ca'Ŧwa'ksa, v. To saw wood. Ca'Ŧwawaksa.

ca'Ŧwa'ka'sica, n. A wooden dish or plate.

ca'Ŧwak'i'Ŧ, n. A saddle. - hu, The saddle bow. - pasu', A saddle horn.

ca'Ŧwa'pe, n. Leaves; small branches. - gi wi, September, the moon in which the leaves turn brown. - Easna' wi, October, the moon when the wind shakes off the leaves. - waka'Ŧ. - wofesma, Thick leaves or foliage. Cf. ca'Ŧiyuwi iyececa.

ca'Ŧwa'pto wi, n. May, the moon in which the leaves are green.

ca'Ŧwa'sleca, v.a. To saw lengthwise. ca'Ŧwa'slecapi, n. Wood sawed lengthwise, a plank, boards; sawing, the making of boards.

ca'Ŧwa'slesleca, v.a. To saw boards, to saw lengthwise of the wood often.

ca'Ŧwa'ta, n. A log canoe, a skiff.

ca'Ŧwi'cajipe, n. A drawing knife.

ca'Ŧwi'cipaga, n. A cross.

ca'Ŧwi'lute, n. Logwood, containing red dye stuff.

ca'Ŧwi'Ŧja, n. A floor.

ca'Ŧwi'pasno'Ŧ, n. A spit or stick to take hold of and roast meat on.

ca'Ŧwi'ta, n. A little grove or island of trees. Cf. ca'Ŧpata.

ca'Ŧwi'yowa, n. (ca'Ŧ, wiyowa). A pencil. Mazwiyowa, A pen.

ca'Ŧwi'yufe, n. A wood measure, a cord stick.

ca'Ŧwi'yuwi, n. Curled wood, a vine.

ca'Ŧwi'yuze, n. A sharp stick to take meat out etc. from a kettle.

ca'Ŧwo'gna'ka, n. A coffin. Note: ca'Ŧo-gnaka, A box.

ca'Ŧwo'jupi, n. A park, a tree nursery; an orchard.
